The Dingle Peninsula is home to Tig Slea Head, an iconic property on the Slea Head Drive, between Ventry and Ballyferriter. This picturesque part of the world is renowned for its dramatic scenery over the Blasket Islands and the Atlantic Ocean. Sitting on the edge of the Wild Atlantic Way, Tig Slea Head is a detached two storey property of c.304 sq m. Built originally as a residential property and used more recently as a café / retail outlet, this property is ideally suited to residential use as a one-off home.

Tig Slea Head offers a blank canvas to work from, whether you are looking for a holiday home, commercial workshop / shop or private home, or a combination of both. The property sits on c.0.42 hectares (1.04 acres) and therefore offers great potential for extension to the rear also. The possibilities are endless with this fabulous property which is ideally located amongst several other businesses in the area such as Louis Mulcahy pottery and the Blasket Centre to mention but a few.

The property sits on the edge of the Slea Head Drive, which is a circular route forming part of the Wild Atlantic Way beginning and ending in

Dingle town. This is one of Ireland's most scenic routes taking in some breathtaking scenery on the western tip of the stunning Dingle Peninsula.

The property is also close to Dun Chaoin Pier, the Dunmore Head viewpoint and overlooks Coumeenoole Beach which is the closest sandy beach in the area.

If ocean views are important to you, then this is the property for you.




