2 STATION HOUSE

Beautifully designed home with stunning views of the entire town of Clonakilty and bay. All accommodation and living areas have the benefit of this vista.

The entrance to the property is via the first floor with a hallway leading straight to a bright open plan living area with dining room, sitting room and kitchen. Ideal for entertaining, doors on both sides of the room lead to the wrap around balcony. The first floor also includes a WC off the hallway with a stairwell leading down to the sleeping accommodation and bathrooms on the ground floor.

All 3 bedrooms face south to take in the views with the larger 2 bedrooms both having doors opening to a second balcony area. The master bedroom is ensuite while the ground floor also includes a family bathroom and utility area.

GROUND

The grounds are designed for low maintenance with wrap around timber cladded steel balconies on both the first and ground floors to take in the southerly views over the town and bay. Parking is available in front of the house.

HISTORY

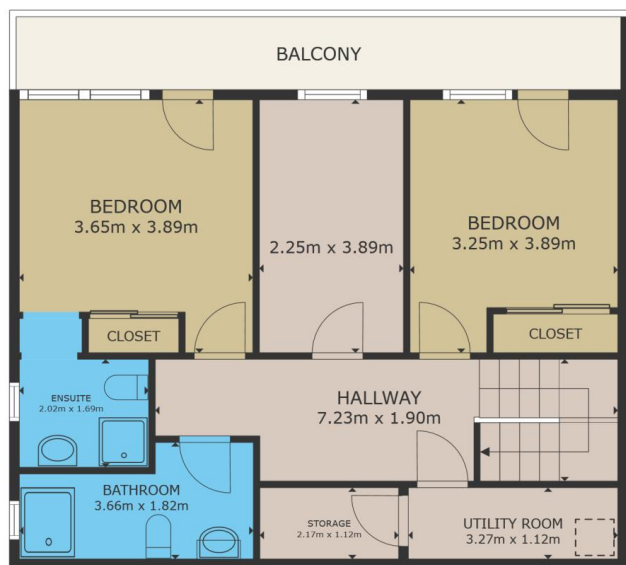
The property was newly built in c.2006 replacing warehouses associated with the old Clonakilty railway which closed in 1961. The front door opens to the former railway platform with the stone fronted station house, which is believed to date to the opening of the railway in 1886, immediately to the west.

LOCATION

The location and convenience of the property off McCurtain Hill is superb. Clonakilty is a popular residential, market and award-winning tourist town that attracts families interested in taking advantage of the fine facilities and amenities including excellent Schools, Shops, Sports and Recreation. The property is convenient to Inchydoney Beach and the many coastal offerings throughout West Cork. Clonakilty is 50 kilometres south west of Cork City and Airport.
