Superbly located just a stone's throw from the famous "Forty Foot" bathing spot and a short distance from Sandycove, Dalkey and Dun Laoghaire where a host of local services and amenities make everyday living a true pleasure in this vibrant local community. A beloved family home for over forty years, Elton is a wonderfully elegant 1930's residence that exudes great character and charm throughout the superb light-filled accommodation. Ideally located on the sunny side of Sandycove Road, it enjoys a private south facing rear garden and generous off-street parking for 5 cars to the front.

Internally the home is rich in original features typical of its era, including a solid mahogany staircase, picture rails, feature fireplaces and bow bay windows. Off the entrance hall to the left there is an inviting dining room with a bow bay window overlooking the front garden. To the right of the hallway there is a large drawing room which also boasts a bow bay window and feature fireplace. To the rear are the kitchen/ breakfast room and a family room, both enjoying access out to the sunroom and sunny patio garden. A shower room completes the accommodation downstairs.

Overhead there are five bedrooms, four doubles and a generous single. The main room to the front of the house enjoys a large bow bay window, exposed timber flooring and a feature fireplace. A large attic, accessible from this room via pull-down stairs, offers potential for extension (approximately 50 sqm). With its generous proportions and ceiling heights this extremely versatile space could be converted for various uses. A large fully tiled family bathroom with a bath & shower cubicle and a separate w.c. completes the upper floor.

## ACCOMMODATION

Entrance Porch: with terracotta tiled floor and decorative stained-glass window.

Entrance Hall: spacious hallway with feature mahogany staircase and understairs storage.

Dining Room: with bow bay window, picture rail and feature fireplace with wood surround and tiled inset.

Drawing room: with bow bay window, picture rails and feature fireplace with wood surround and tiled inset.

Kitchen/ Breakfast room: with a selection of fitted wall and floor units, tiled splashback, stainless steel sink unit and terracotta tiled floor. A door opens out to the sunroom.

Family Room: with picture rail and a feature fireplace with solid wood surround and tiled inset. A door opens out to the sunroom.

Sunroom: spacious sunroom with tiled floors and double doors opening out to the garden.

Bathroom: fully tiled with w.c, bath, wash hand basin and shower cubicle.

Bedroom 1: generous room to the front with polished timber floors, bow bay window, picture rails, feature fireplace with solid wood surround and tiled inset. Access to attic.
