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About this property

Foirnis, formerly known as Atlantis House, is a distinguished Victorian residence occupying a prominent position within the coastal village of Burtonport. Long established as a local landmark, it combines classical architectural elegance with a uniquely compelling cultural heritage. Dating from 1895, this substantial home extends to well-maintained grounds of about 1.4 acres and retains a wealth of original features, including sash windows, high ceilings, decorative coving and period fireplaces.

The accommodation is elegant and well-balanced. A feature double-door entrance porch with stained glass panels opens to a grand reception hall, complete with timber flooring, ceiling coving and a staircase rising to the first floor. To either side, two bay-fronted reception rooms provide excellent symmetry. The family room to the right and the living room to the left both feature high ceilings with centrepieces, timber floors, large sash windows and open fireplaces, offering well-proportioned and versatile living spaces.

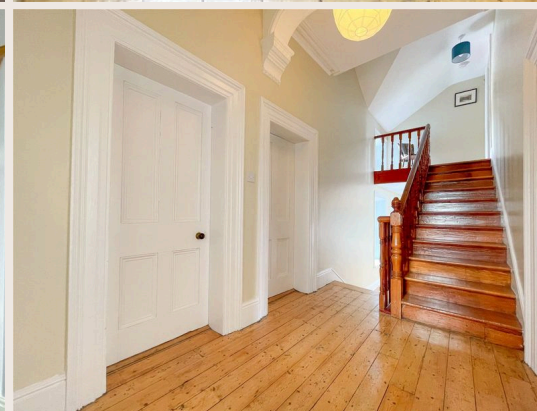
From the hall, the layout continues through to an inner hallway with under-stair storage, leading to a ground floor bathroom. To the rear, a well-proportioned dining room with open fireplace, sash windows and decorative coving connects naturally to the kitchen. The

kitchen/breakfast room is fully fitted with granite worktops and tiled flooring, and benefits from a traditional half-door opening to a sheltered patio. A generous utility room, rear hallway with access to the back door, guest WC and fully tiled wet room complete the ground floor. Upstairs, the main staircase rises to a series of bright landings with timber flooring and feature sash windows, including a decorative stained glass panel over the stairs. There are four well-proportioned bedrooms, all retaining original character. The master bedroom includes a separate dressing room area with its own fireplace and independent access. A compact studio/office with stained glass door and large sash window overlooks the front gardens. A spacious main bathroom with bath and separate shower serves this level, while one bedroom also benefits from an ensuite.

A secondary staircase leads to a further wing comprising four additional bedrooms, one of which enjoys views towards Arranmore Island. These four bedrooms are served by a family bathroom.

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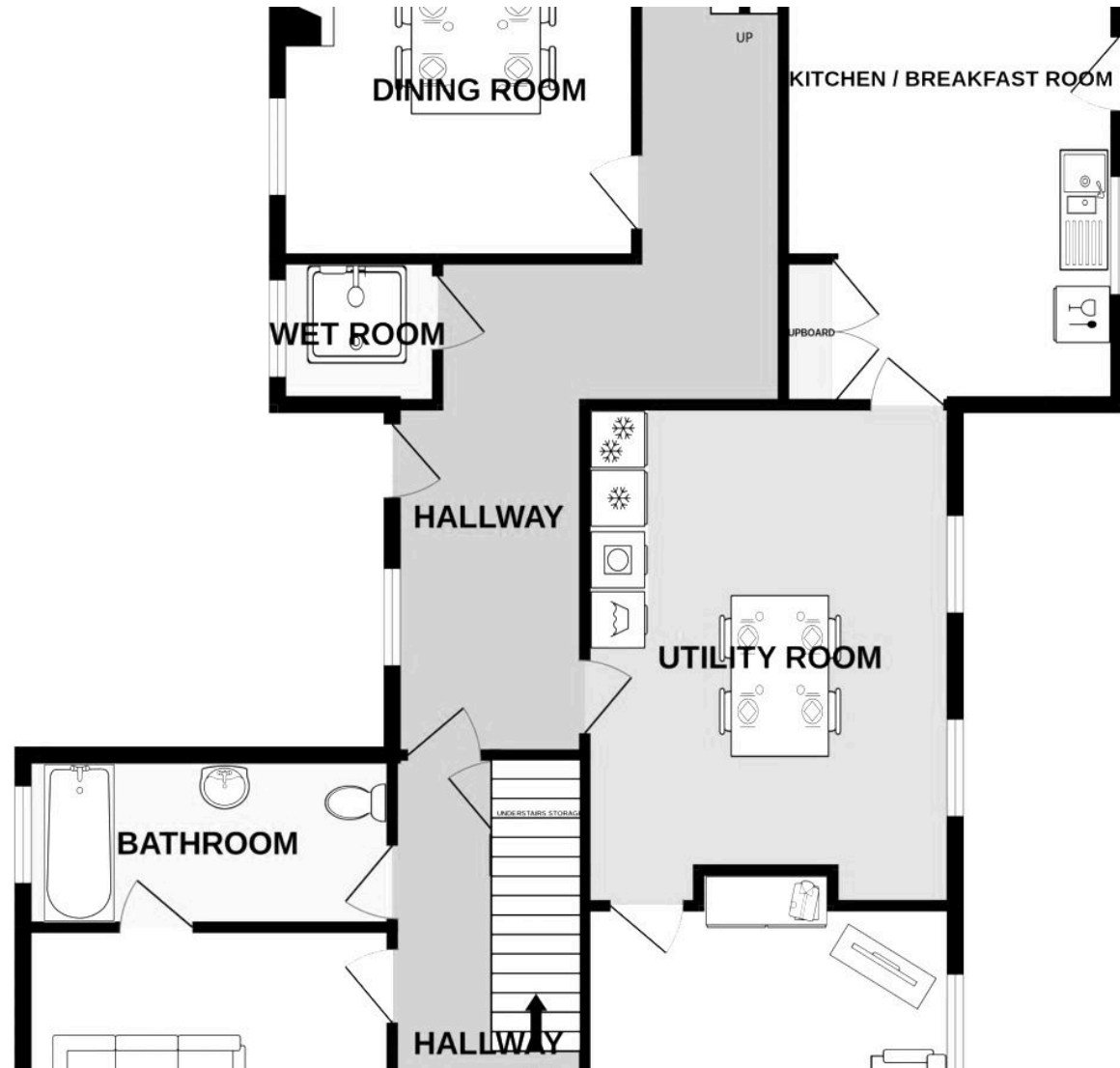

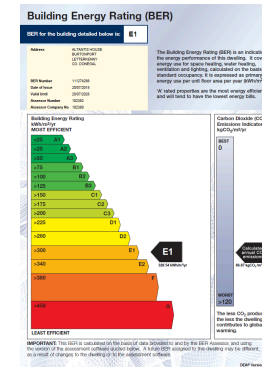
Services & Additional Information
