The property which has a wonderful sense of space incorporates many notable features synonymous with the Victorian era, including nicely appointed reception rooms, attractive ceiling coving, picture rails and sash windows.

Upon entering no. 1 Derrynane Terrace, one will immediately notice that this property offers light filled and deceptively spacious accommodation. The entrance hall with its high ceilings leads to the gracious living room featuring a bay window and attractive ceiling coving. Double doors open into the study, which in turn leads through to the kitchen/dining room with doors opening out to the private west facing rear garden. Off the kitchen there is a spacious utility room/pantry and a gust w.c in the hallway completes the downstairs accommodation.

Upstairs the accommodation consists of four impressive bedrooms; the fourth is currently in use as a walk-in wardrobe and could easily be converted back to a bedroom. Completing the accommodation at this level is a generous bathroom.



Ideally positioned on Convent Road, the list of local amenities and services is almost endless. They include excellent schools, a selection of speciality shops, restaurants and maritime facilities, public transport including the DART, not to mention the picturesque walks of Coliemore Road, Killiney and Dalkey Hills.

Ground Floor

Entrance Hall: light filled hallway with wood effect flooring, Living room: with polished timber floors, bay window and feature fireplace with brass inset. Double doors open through to the dining room/ study.

Study/ Dining: originally the dining room this is currently used as a study. Features polished timber floors and a decorative tiled fireplace with cassette stove. Steps lead through to the kitchen.

Kitchen/ Dining: with fitted units, shelving, timber solid timber counter tops, Belfast sink, gas hob, extractor fan, centre island and Aga with feature brick surround. There is a spacious dining area for entertaining.

Utility Room: with a selection of fitted wall and floor units. Guest w.c: with w.c and wash hand basin.

First Floor

Landing: spacious light filled landing.

Bedroom 1: spacious double bedroom to the front of the house with sliding sash window and exposed polished floors.

Bedroom 2: spacious double bedroom to the rear of the house with exposed timber floors and sliding sash windows.

Bedroom 3: spacious single room to the front of the house with sliding sash windows and exposed timber floors.

Bedroom 4/ office: currently used as a walk-in wardrobe this room has a sliding sash window and exposed timber floors.

Bathroom: partly tiled with w.c, jacuzzi bath, and shower cubicle with overhead shower.

GARDEN

Garden: The front of the property is exceptionally private, set back behind a laurel hedge and with original cast iron railings, paving and planted beds. There is side access to the rear garden which enjoys a westerly orientation and is very private. It is paved, with a selection of plants, and bounded by a granite wall. There is a Barna shed to the side for additional storage.
