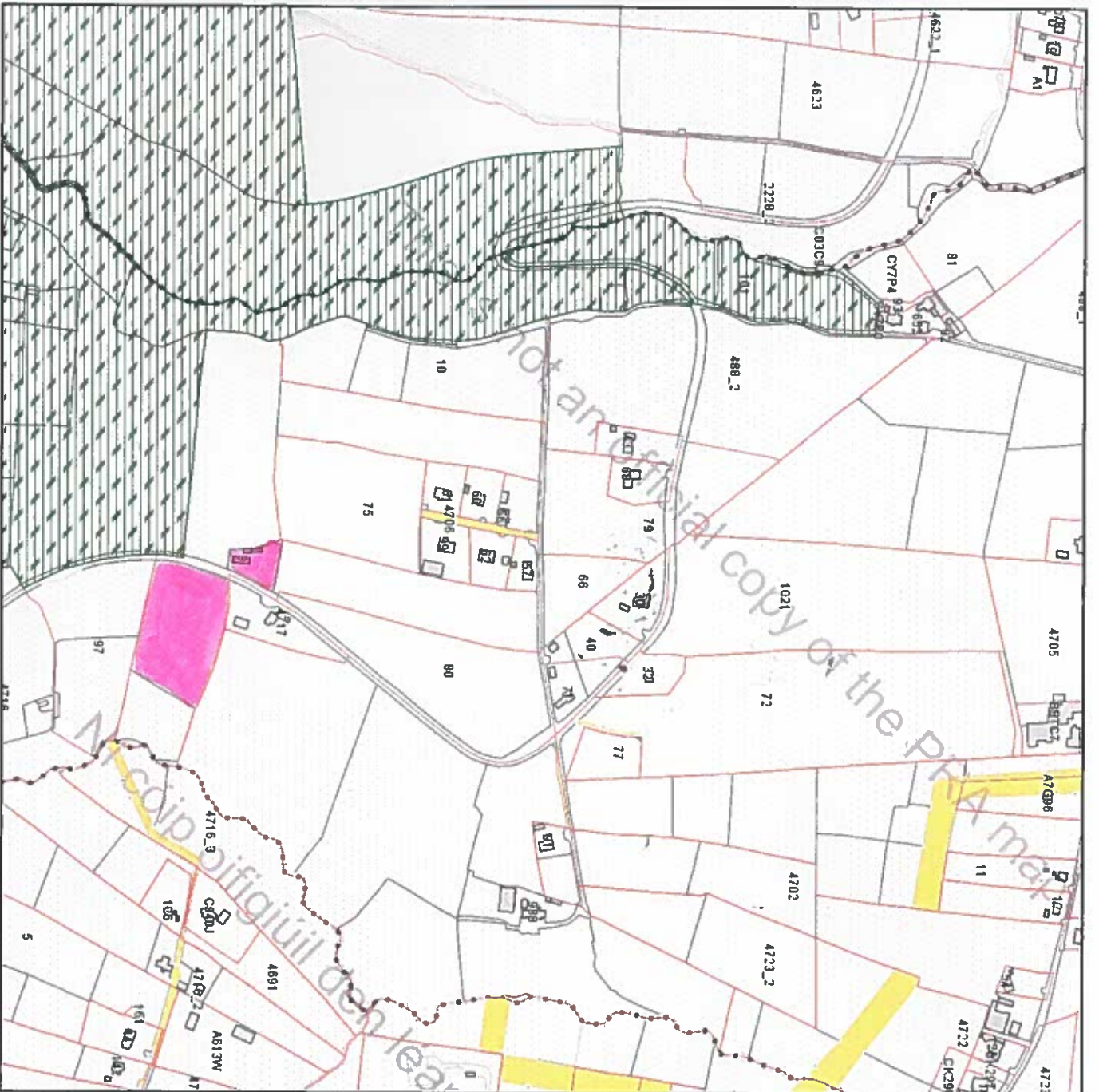
Official Property Registration Map
