Only high end products and materials have been used throughout this project. For example, the hardware in the bathrooms are Burlington fittings, the kitchen counter tops are Silestone, composite quartz and the kitchen benefits from 2 sinks, one being a beautiful Belfast sink. The kitchen flooring is porcelain tile, brick look which has a slip rating of 10+. Both smoke alarms and carbon monoxide alarms are hardwired in the house. Wifi is also hardwired throughout the property. The property has not been finished out completely which will allow the new owner to put their own unique stamp on the property.

The property requires some internal finishes and can easily be adapted to suit lifestyle uses including Airbnb, Retreat House, Yoga Centre, Art Studio or creating a multi-generational home.

















