



Ormond View, Ballycrissane, Ballinasloe, Co. Galway.







Prepared to be charmed by this delightful stone built two-storey farm residence (dating back to approx. 1820) standing in private gardens and pasture lands comprising 9 ha (22.3 acres). This Property has retained its original period features and is approached by a sweeping gravel driveway. To the rear of the dwelling house there is a courtyard with private stables and outbuildings.

Set in good quality grassland (which could be subdivided into paddocks). This holding offers and extensive road frontage with potential for site development (subject to planning permission).

"Ormond View" is quietly situated in a friendly rural district within 8km of Portumna (on the river Shannon) which is renowned for its water sports facilities, shops and famous pubs/restaurants. There is also excellent Primary & Secondary schools. It is also 28 km of Loughrea and 25 km of Ballinasloe.

It is seldom the opportunity arises to procure a Property of such immense character enjoying complete privacy and tranquillity in this particular location and inspection thereof is confidently recommended.

Bedroom 2 3m x 4.8m (9'10" x 15'9"): Rear aspect window with original shutters, open fireplace with wooden surround, carpet flooring

Bedroom 3 Front and side aspect original sash windows with original shutters, open fire place with castiron insert and wooden surround, carpet flooring

En-Suite (Jack & Jill) 2.4m x 3.4m (7'10" x 11'2"): Original sash window with original shutters, corner shower/bidet/dual handbasins/wc, tile flooring

Office 3.9m x 4.1m (12'10" x 13'5"): Cast-iron fireplace, wooden flooring

Bedroom 4 4.8m x 5.5m (15'9" x 18'1"): Front and side aspect original sash windows with original shutters, open fireplace with wooden surround, carpet flooring
