THE WHITE HOUSE

An elegant entrance hall greets you. With its period style door, polished tile floor and original staircase, it opens to a lounge and sitting room at the front of the house. These reception rooms are fitted with fireplaces and period style detailing.

The impressive kitchen with an attractive dining room, utility and guest washroom lie beyond the reception rooms. The kitchen is a feature of this fine property with its bespoke period style hand painted units, Belfast sink and polished granite worktops. Patio doors from the conservatory open onto a marvellous raised patio and enclosed gardens.

Upstairs the four bedrooms, three ensuite, are all generous in size and enjoy harbour and street views. The bedrooms and various bathrooms combine luxury and modern comforts with original design features.

The master suite on the top floor has a balcony taking full advantage of the scenic vista of Castletownshend's harbour.
