A teak door with glass paneling allows access to an open plan living/dining room. This super area has one window to the front of the property, attractive décor, plenty of space for a dining table, an open plan cloak room, one centre light fitting, an open attractive fire place with a brick surround. one large radiator, ample power points and one tv point.







A galley style kitchen with modern fitted units at eye and floor level with an extensive worktop counter and tile splash back. The kitchen has space for fridge/freezer, cooker, washing machine and a fitted stainless steel sink. There is one radiator,

one fluorescent light tube, four power points, vinyl flooring and tiled walls. A solid door leads into the bathroom.



Located off the kitchen, this stylish bathroom features a three piece suite with a showerhead fitted over the bath. The area has impressive tiled flooring, fully tiled walls and one velux window allowing in natural light, one centre light fitting, one wall mounted light fitting and integrated storage under the sink.



Stairs in the open plan living/dining allow access up to the first floor landing. The landing has timber flooring, one centre light fitting and solid doors lead into the two bedrooms.

A doorway allows access to the attic stairway, with a window placed here for natural daylight. The stairs are solid wood and have been sanded and varnished to a high quality finish. This spacious double bedroom is located to the front of the property and has two windows that

allow in extensive natural light. The room has timber flooring, neutral décor, one centre light fitting, one radiator and ample power points.
